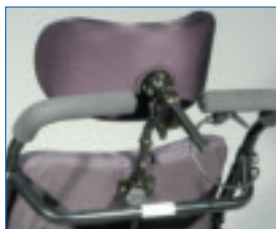

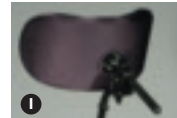
1. Adjustable angle back from 90 to 110 degrees
2. Seat to floor heights from 14.5" to 18.75"



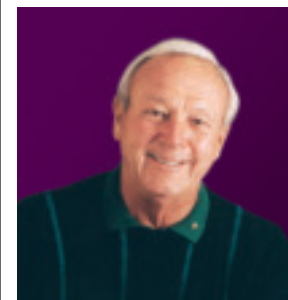
New back posts to ensure client comfort. Allows for better headrest adjustability.
